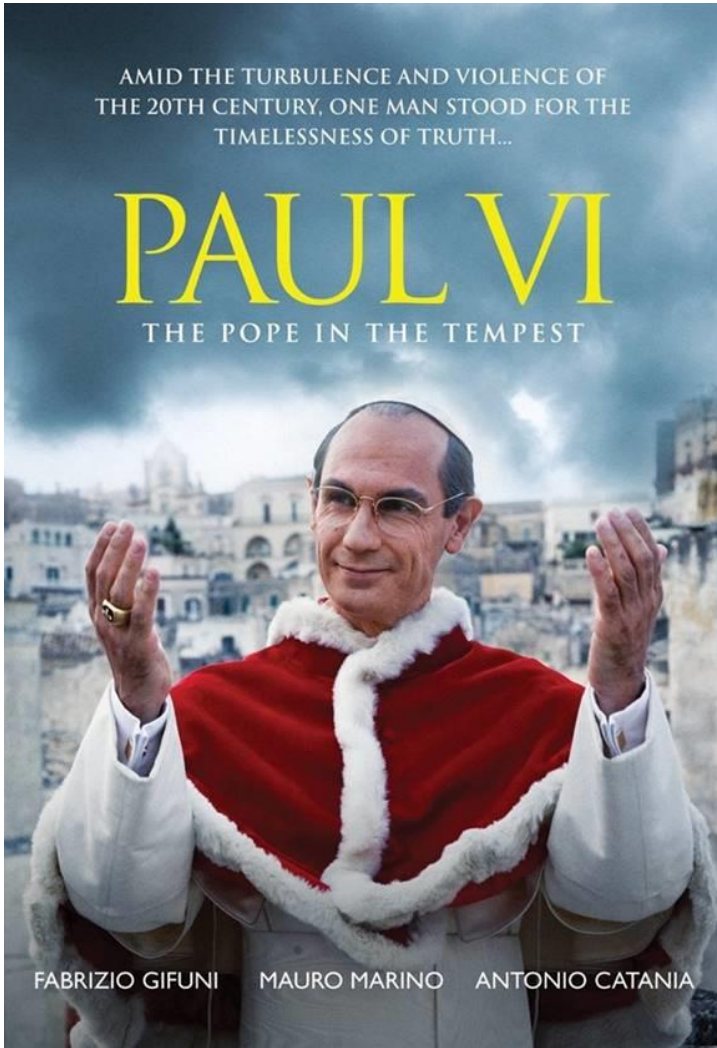

Friday's Movie and Potluck, see you there!

Pope Paul VI was a leader in the Catholic Church as a priest, bishop, cardinal and pope through one of the most difficult periods in its history from the Fascist regime and World War II to the constitution of the Italian Republic, from the Second Vatican Council to the protests and the terrorist attacks of the 1960s and 1970s. During his papacy he wrote the prophetic, controversial document *Humane Vitae* that strongly proclaimed the Church's teaching on the sacredness of married love and human life. He was the first travelling Pope

who began to visit the dioceses of the five continents like no pope had ever done before. Paul VI was the pope who opened a dialogue among religions: for the first time a Pope visited Jerusalem, the Holy Land. This beautifully produced and well-acted movie is a journey into the past of both Italy and the world, amid wars and continuous upheavals. This exciting and insightful film covers fifty years of history that changed the Catholic Church and the world. St. Pope Paul VI was canonized by Pope Francis on October 14, 2018.
